## Tribes and Rancherias Get Ready to ShakeOut!

**At 10:20 a.m. on October 20, 2011**, millions of Californians will “Drop, Cover, and Hold On” in The Great California ShakeOut, the largest earthquake drill ever! All Tribes and Rancherias are encouraged to participate in the drill (or plan a more extensive exercise).

Major earthquakes may happen anywhere you work, live, or travel in California. The ShakeOut is our chance to practice how to protect ourselves, and for everyone to become prepared. The goal is to prevent a major earthquake from becoming a catastrophe for you, your family, and your community.



Why is a “Drop, Cover, and Hold On” drill important? As with anything to act quickly you must practice often. You may only have seconds to protect yourself in an earthquake before strong shaking knocks you down, or something falls on you.

More than 7.9 million Southern Californians participated in the 2010 ShakeOut statewide. The Great California ShakeOut will be held on the third Thursday of October each year.

**Everyone can participate!** Individuals, families, businesses, schools, colleges, government agencies and organizations are all invited to register.

### HOW TO PARTICIPATE

#### Plan Your Drill:

- Register at [www.ShakeOut.org/register](http://www.ShakeOut.org/register) to be counted in the ShakeOut Drill, get email updates, and more.
- Download a Drill Broadcast recording from [www.ShakeOut.org/drill/broadcast](http://www.ShakeOut.org/drill/broadcast).
- Have a “Drop, Cover, and Hold On” drill at 10:20 a.m. on October 20. You may also want to coordinate a more extensive exercise of your emergency plan.
- Discuss what you learned and make improvements.

#### Get Prepared for Earthquakes:

- Secure building contents with seismic restraints.
- Learn about CISM tools for your DOCs.
- Encourage employees to prepare at home.
- Be sure there are fresh, accessible supplies to support your personnel while they manage an event.
- Provide CERT training for employees.

#### Share the ShakeOut:

- Outreach to all stakeholders to encourage everyone to register, prepare and drill.
- Emphasize the importance of personal preparedness.
