Timeline:

- 3:00 am: Set up begins (including Big Shaker, partner tables)
- 3:30 am: Media arrival begins
- 4:00 am -11:00 am: Subject Matter Expert Interviews
 - Local TV and radio can start interviews with available subject matter experts and/or Ready America (in their Big Shaker) as early as 4:00 am.
 - This is also an opportunity for reporters to learn and share more about SoCal earthquakes and preparedness.
- 8:00-8:30 am: Press Conference;
 - Speakers will highlight the drill happening at SCE, the importance of ShakeOut Drills, announcements of other initiatives, and instructions for tours that follow.
- 9:00 am: Walking tour of SCE's laydown yard to see equipment and resources staged for SCE's power restoration exercise
- 10:10 am: Media invited to SCE media center overlooking their Emergency Operations Center, to observe the main Drop, Cover, Hold On exercise
